**1. Stark Tech – Generator – Annual Agreement –**

On **MOTION** by Councilman Armitage and seconded by Councilman Fox and passed unanimously with voting as follows: Council Armitage, Fox, Johnson and Deputy Supervisor Paddock – aye the following **RESOLUTION:**

**RESOLVED**, the Town Board of the Town of LeRoy authorizes Stark Tech to provide annual maintenance services for the generator located at the Town Hall, 48 Main Street, LeRoy for the year 2026 at a cost of \$1,072.26 with scope of work listed in contract on file.
