Paul Bishop, CGR Consolidation –

Paul Bishop presented to Town Board and Village Trustee members proposal for consolidating the Village of LeRoy with the Town inclusive of information packet for review and feasibility of moving forward.

OLD BUSINESS:

1. Water District No. 12 – Update/Information –

Property owner of West Bergen Road has requested the water main be brought in from West Bergen Road instead of Griswold Road. There is no issue from engineering standpoint but will need to contact MCWA for approval. Morsch Pipeline will begin construction in late spring to start the Northwest section and then will look to provide change orders to provide pricing on the remaining three sections.
